

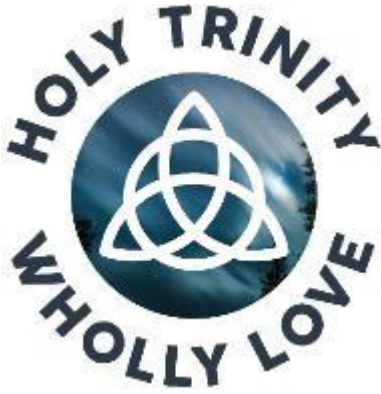

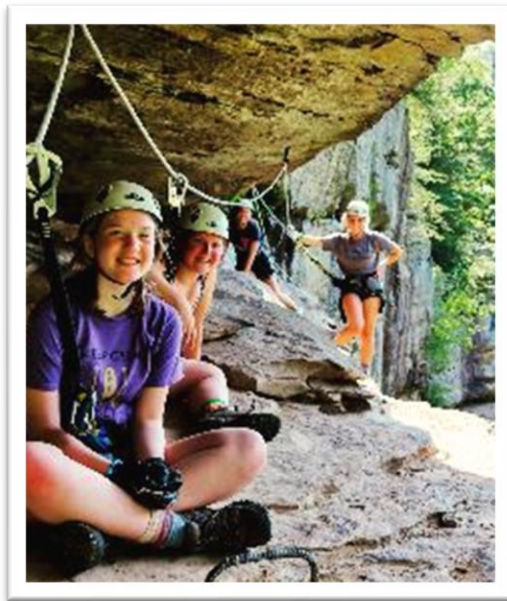

What's your favorite season and holiday?

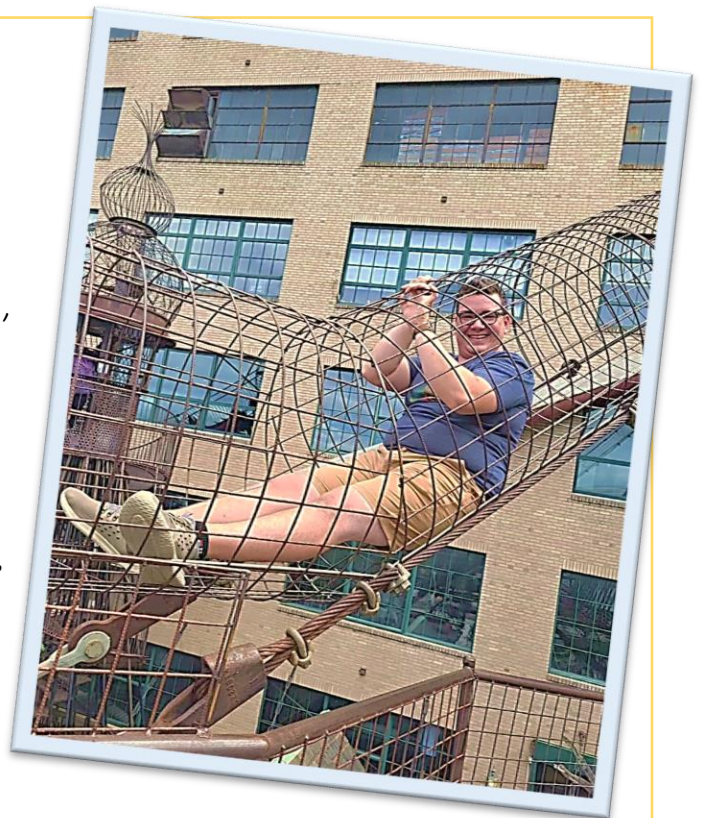
