Camp Scholarship Policy

The purpose of this policy is to outline the LOMIK procedures for parents/guardians applying for and receiving camp scholarships. Following this policy will enable the organization to fulfill its oversight responsibility over the funds it is entrusted to manage an maintain our philosophy and practice at LOMIK that no child be denied a summer camp experience due to financial need.

Each child is eligible for ONE scholarship per year. Parents are encouraged to pay a \$50 non-refundable deposit for each child. If a family has multiple children the sibling discount would apply after all deposits have been made for each camper in the family. Home congregations are encouraged to assist their families' camper fees. The maximum LOMIK scholarship amount is \$400 per child.

Scholarship Process:

- 1. Parents/Guardians register their campers online, noting the request for scholarship and pay the deposit as they are able.
- 2. Parents/Guardians who do not register their campers online, will need to fill out the scholarship application and email that to <u>info@lomik.org</u> or mail to the office at LOMIK 5215 North 450 West, Angola, IN 46703.
- 3.. LOMIK determines the level of financial aid we can provide toward the week of camp.
- 4. LOMIK sends an email accepting the registration for the camper with the health form and additional important information about the LOMIK summer camp experience. In case of a paper registration that was mailed, the office will reach out to the family via phone or email with that information.

Families that receive scholarships are encouraged to write a thank you note in the end of summer survey that will be shared with LOMIK donors who provided scholarship funds sharing the value of their child(ren)'s camp experience and comments about the overall camp week(s).
