LOMIK offers residential Christian camp experiences where relationships with God and one another are explored at each of our three sites.

Campers experience a wide variety of age appropriate activities in small and large groups. Bible study, games, hiking, swimming, crafts, devotions, worship, campfires, and music play a part in the excitement of a week at camp.

Summer programs are staffed by fun, enthusiastic, college-aged counselors who love working with kids, come highly recommended, and have positive attitudes towards life. Their Christian faith plays a role in their everyday lives. Their words and actions show they use good judgement in the care of themselves and others.

All camps are full weeks, Sunday through Friday, except for Pilgrim Camp and Staff Alumni Family Camp which are Sunday through Wednesday (*).

Teacher referral and test scores are requested prior to camp.
